
Christmas Fayre

Reminders of expectations:

Children should be *reading at least 3 times per week*. This helps them attain the rewards they deserve.

Children's attendance should be above 97% - please avoid missing any days from school unless ill.

Absence calls must be made by a parent or carer by calling the school office before **9.10am.** There is a designated answer machine for absence messages. Miss Hodson will then follow up any attendance queries as needed.
