**Absences**—Please ensure you call the absentee phone line before 9.10am to report your child's absence along with the reason. As per our policy we cannot accept notification via email. **Road Safety** 

Recently we have had a couple of near misses where cars have been mounting the pavement when turning in the road, please be aware of the dangers this is causing to our children and families.

DO NOT PARK ON THE ZIG ZAGS OR YELLOW LINES

**Safeguarding** Children can only be released to previously agreed people [adults/siblings]- if you need someone else to collect your child you **must** inform the office in advance.

#### Reminders of expectations:

Children should be *reading at least 3 times per week*. This helps them attain the rewards they deserve.

Children's attendance should be above 97% - please avoid missing any days from school unless ill.

Absence calls must be made by a parent or carer by calling the school office before **9.10am**. There is a designated answer machine for absence messages. Miss Hodson will then follow up any attendance queries as needed.

For safety reasons; <u>No hoodies or jewellery</u> for PE. PE T-shirts should be plain white, Joggers should be plain black or Navy. PE kit is uniform not outdoor learning/forest clothing.

School gates open at 8:35am and close at 8:45am.
