**UNIFORM-** please put your child's name in each part of the uniform- this reduces lost property. We have many items in lost property already, since starting back in September!



Children should be <u>reading at least 3 times per week</u>. This helps them attain the rewards they deserve.

**Reminders of expectations:** 

Children's attendance should be **above 97%** - please avoid missing any days from school unless ill. Absence calls must be made by a parent or carer by calling the school office before **9.10am.** There is a designated answer machine for absence messages. Miss Hodson will then follow up any attendance queries as needed.

For safety reasons; <u>No hoodies or jewellery</u> for PE. PE T-shirts should be plain white, Joggers should be plain black or Navy. PE kit is uniform not outdoor learning/forest clothing.

School gates open at 8:35am and close at 8:45am. Children arriving after 8:45am miss the start of learning and are marked as late!
