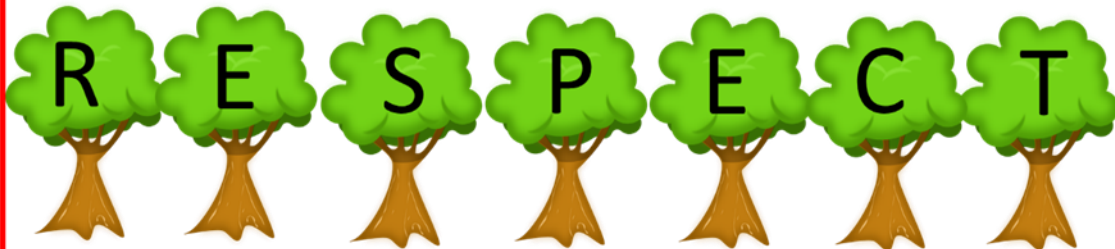

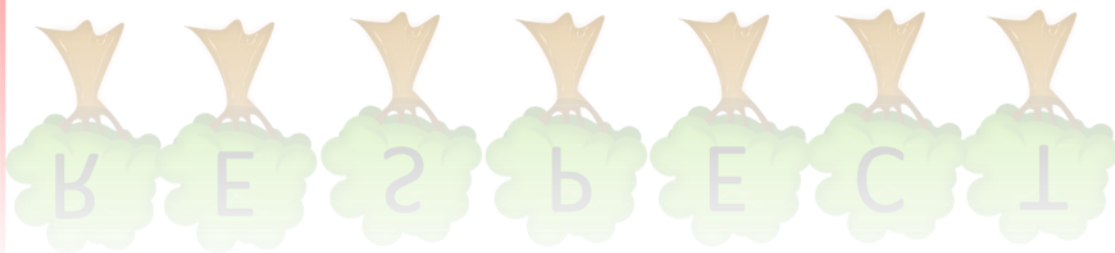



<p>1/2</p> 	<p><u>Bright Lights, Big City</u></p> <p><i>What is a city? What can you find there? Explore London and its landmarks, learn all about the Great Plague, the Fire of London and visit the Queen for tea at Buckingham Palace!</i></p> <p><u>Key knowledge and skills:</u></p> <p>Science:- Seasonal changes.</p> <p>English:- Narrative, letters and instructions.</p> <p>Maths:- Place value, addition and subtraction and shape.</p> <p>PE:- Gymnastics and throwing and catching.</p>
<p>3/4</p> 	<p><u>Mighty Metals!</u></p> <p><i>What are metals? What are they used for? Take a journey through the history of transport: where did it all begin? Explore transport through the ages, from river boats to rockets!</i></p> <p><u>Key knowledge and skills:</u></p> <p>Science:- Magnets</p> <p>English:- Narrative, list poetry and non-chronological reports.</p> <p>Maths:- Place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication.</p> <p>PE:- Dance and football</p>
<p>5/6</p> 	<p><u>Beast Creator</u></p> <p><i>Take a journey across the globe and explore some of the world's mini-beasts; where can they be found? What are their physical features that help them to survive?
