Dear Families,

We thank all those families who have followed guidance and brought their children back to school. The children are happy and progressing well. They are making full use of the resources and school environment and the teachers are continuing to be caring, nurturing and engaging. We encourage all Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 families to bring their children back to school. Please contact the school if you wish for your child to return.

Teachers are continuing to care for the children in their class but also at home with weekly calls being made to all families. A designated teacher is working with all families to help with home learning and use of the National Oak Academy.

From today, all families who are continuing with distance learning will be able to contact school on a new email address. This email address is distancelearning@woodlands.staffs.sch.uk and can be used to seek advice and celebrate [not marking] what is happening in your home learning lessons. The emails will be checked daily and responded to as soon as possible- however, this may not be the same day. We would like to start sharing a celebration of work, each week, from our distance learners e.g: growing plants, fantastic Topic projects, 100% on a quiz, building a bird house, day - the list is endless. A WOW presentation, where children will be able to show off the amazing things they have achieved at home will be uploaded on to the website each week.
