IMPORTANT PE message

As a school we follow national guidance for PE that states that children ARE NOT PERMITTED to wear jewellery [including earrings] for PE - this is to protect them and the other children from scratches, tearing or pulling.



Please ensure that your child either takes out their earring the day of PE or is able to extract them themselves before the lesson. Necklaces should also not be worn.

The wearing of a plaster is only permitted in exceptional circumstances and staff are not permitted to administer plasters. If, for a short period of time your child needs to cover the earring with a plaster, please send your child with them.

Please also remember **small stud** earrings are the only ear rings permitted in school.

Homework

We are looking at the current homework policy and what is sent home for children to do to help them learn.

Please continue to help your child's learning by practising reading, spelling and times tables every day where possible. These 3 activities everyday make a huge difference to a child's progress.
