The children had a great time celebrating the 80th anniversary of the end of the war in Europe. There was music, history, art and much more. Some of the children's artwork was outstanding and received Green cards.

Each class had their own 'street party' to celebrate this important event.

As well as celebrating VE day this half term—Summer 1 the children have started learning:

Foundation- It's a Kind of Magic! Exploring Fairy Tales and other magical stories, Exploring change in Materials, Understanding numbers to 10 and beyond.

Year 1— School Days Project, they recently visited Nuneaton Heritage Centre learning about traditional Victorian classes comparing it to schooling today. They are learning to describe the passage of time through study of past, present and future tense vocabulary.

Year 2- Magnificent Monarchs History, looking at Kings and Queens from the past. Year 2 are visiting Warwick Castle tomorrow to further their learning on this topic. They are also learning about at animal survival, habitats and food chains.

Year 3 and 4- Emperors and Empires project, learning about the growth and decline of the Roman Republic and the Roman Empire. Plant nutrition and reproduction project, learning to link plant structure to function and identify plant parts associated with water transport and reproduction.

Year 5 and 6—Britain at War, this project teaches the children about the causes, events and consequences of the First and Second World War, the influence of new inventions on warfare.

Today is the start of the nationwide SATS for all Y6 children across the country. We wish all of Y6 the best in their SATS as they recall all their learning from across the years in English and Maths.
