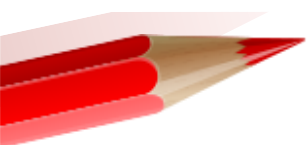
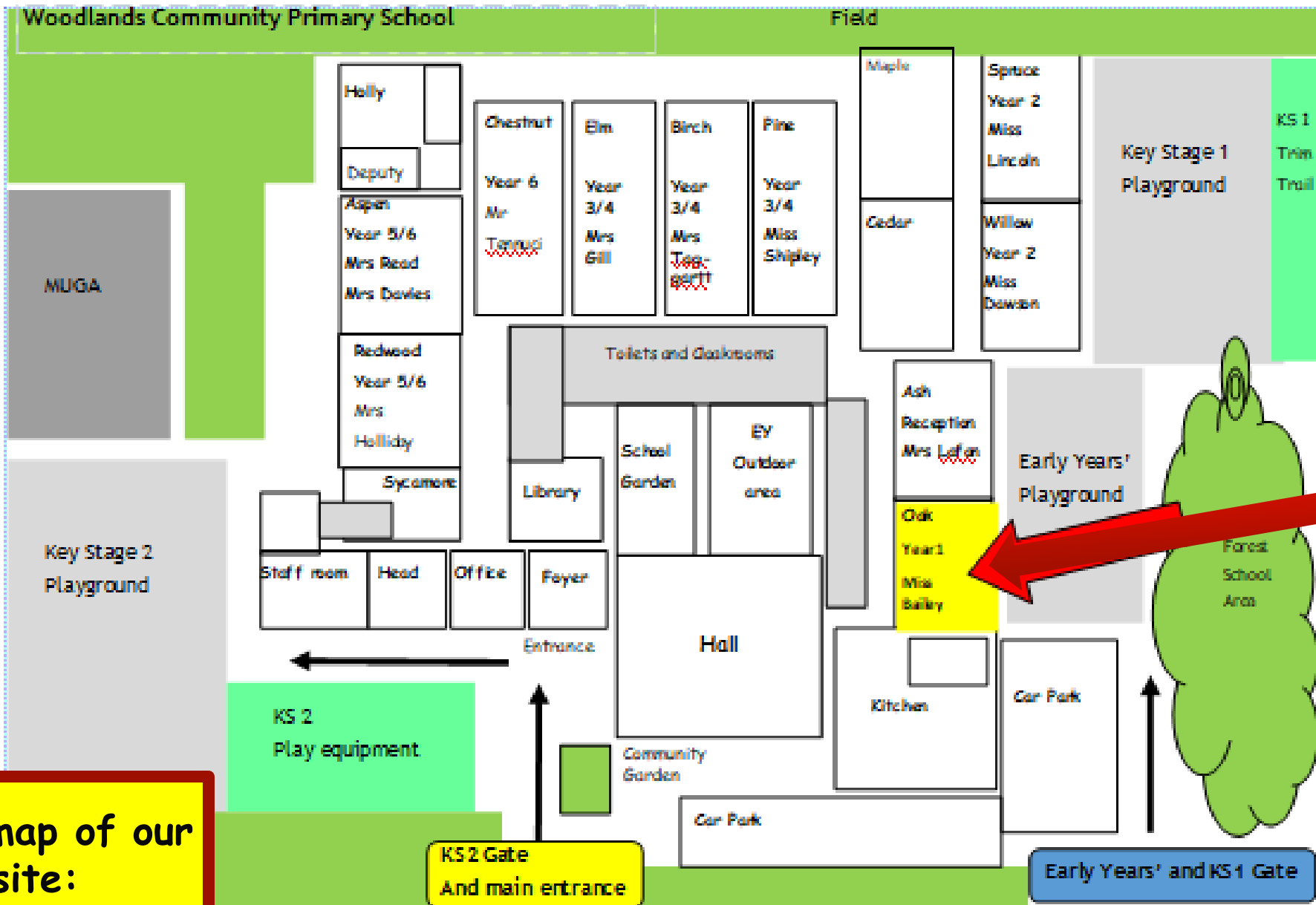
I am really looking forward to getting to know you and teaching you on Thursdays and Fridays next year!

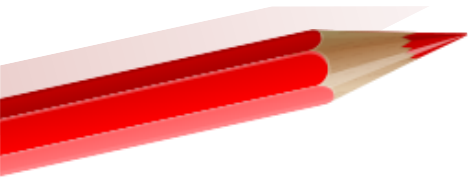

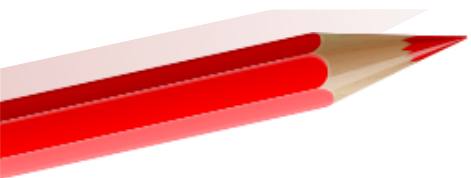


