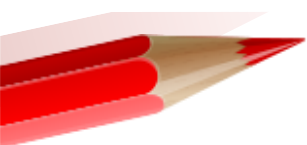
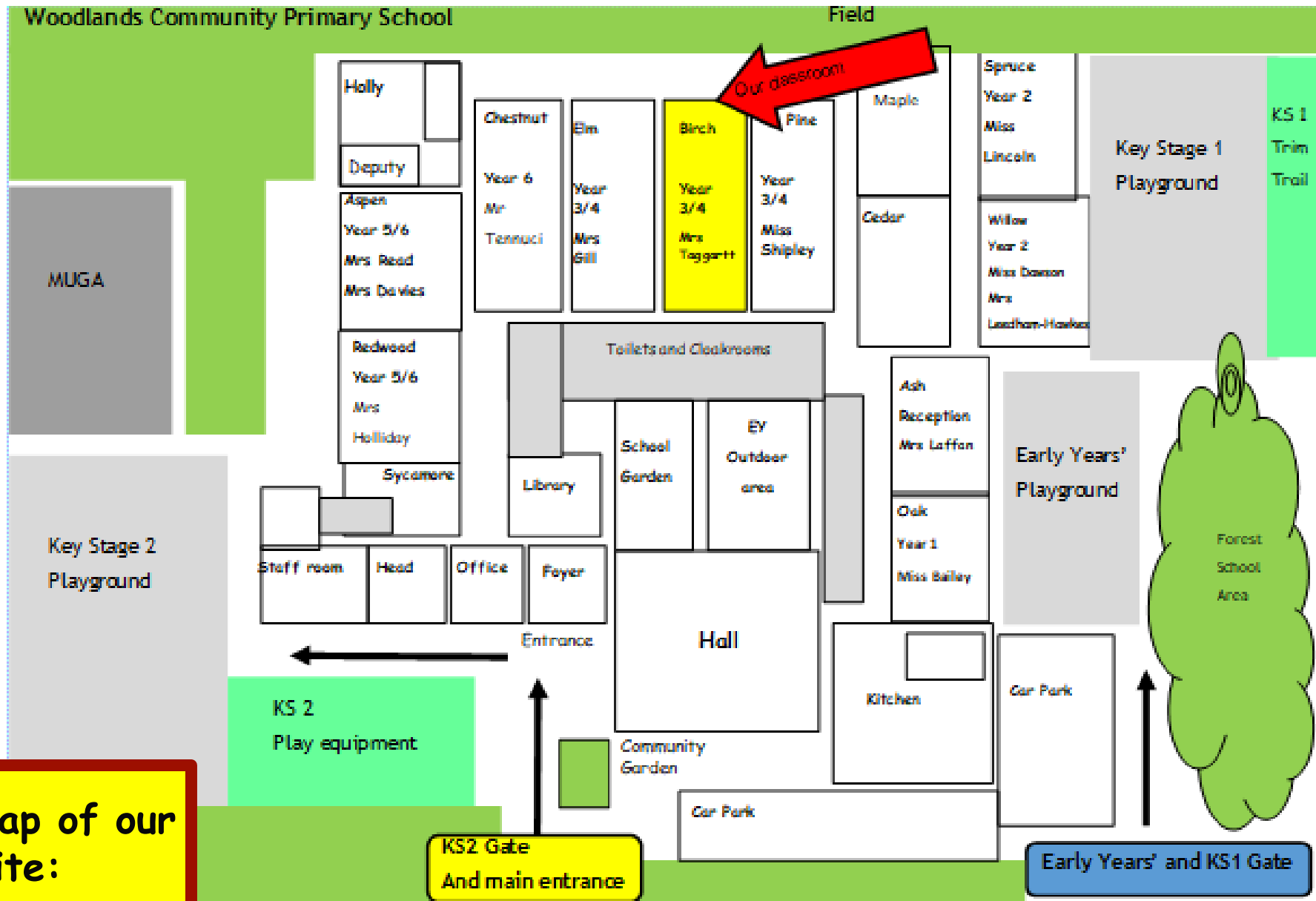
Hi everyone! I'm new to Woodlands Primary and I am so excited to get started and have the best year with you all!

Learning ends and gates will open at 3:15pm. Children will leave school at 3:20pm





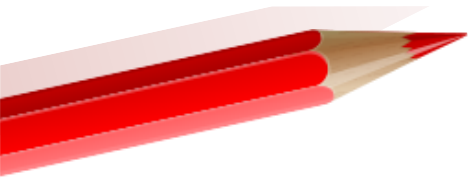

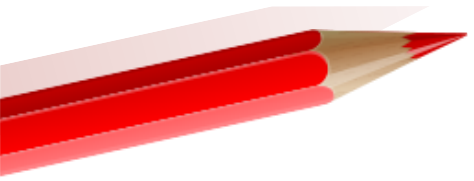


