Facts about me:

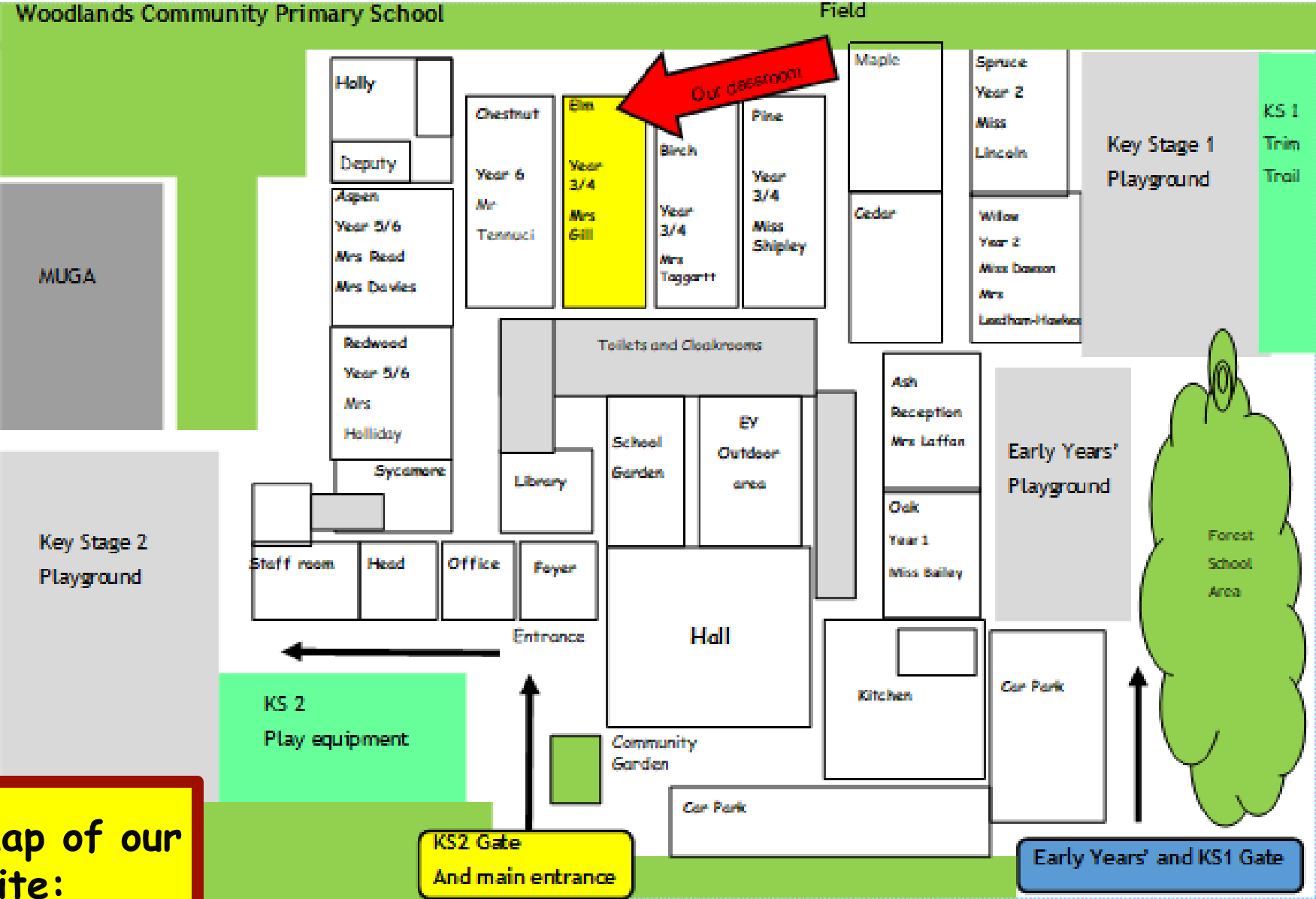
As you can see from the picture, I love Disney, especially Donald Duck. My favourite Disney films are Tangled and Encanto.

Learning ends and gates will open at 3:15pm. Children will leave school at 3:20pm







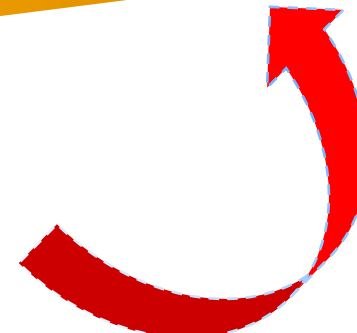
Which house are you in?
