#### **Reminders of expectations:**



Children should be <u>reading at least 3 times per week.</u> This helps them attain the rewards they deserve.

Children's attendance should be **above 97**% - please avoid missing any days from school unless ill. Absence calls must be made by a parent or carer by calling the school office before **9.10am**. There is a designated answer machine for absence messages. Miss Hodson will then follow up any attendance queries as needed.
