Safeguarding

Children can only be released to previously agreed people [adults/siblings]- if you need someone else to collect your child you must inform the office in advance.

If this person is not known to the school the office will ask for contact details.

Reading

Reading at home is the MOST important factor to helping children learn in all subjects. Children should read at home AT LEAST 3 times per week

Uniform

The school uniform requirements are on the website and in each class booklet that came home. Please make sure that you have full uniform ready for September—including PE uniform- PLAIN white t shirt and dark blue/ black shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Tops should have no hoods.

Jewellery

Children are NOT to wear jewellery at school other than simple stud earrings. We have had some upset children through losing or breaking their jewellery.

ParentPay — Please remember to log in to ParentPay and clear any amounts owing. It is preferred if you can top up your child's Dinner Money or Breakfast Club balances prior to the dinners being taken or attending Breakfast Club. If you require login details please contact the school office.

Reminders of expectations:
